Travel Grants:

Travel grants are available for associated faculty for the following activities:

- Traveling to sister UNC System Universities, industry, or national laboratories to engage with potential collaborators and explore synergistic research topics that align with the CAMAC mission.
- Outreach travel to companies to explore opportunities for their engagement with CAMAC
- Travel to domestic conferences to report the results from projects funded through CAMAC seed grants.

Application and selection process

At least 3 weeks before the planned travel, send a one page document containing the following information to the Center Director.

- Names of those travelling
- Destination (must be domestic - no international travel)
- Reason for the travel (see above for supported activities) and expected outcomes
- Details of the requested budget

The center director in conjunction with the leadership team will assess the request within 3 working days and inform the PI via email if the request is approved or not. Applications can be submitted at any time and are subject to availability of funds. Approx. \$20,000 is available this academic year.

Deliverables:

Upon return from travel, a brief report of the activities must accompany the submission of the travel receipts. Report details include:

- Names of the travelers
- Dates and destination of travel
- Details of with whom you engaged with, and discussed CAMAC activities, i.e. company contact, or university faculty member, etc.
- Outcomes from the meeting and any planned follow up activities

Note: Non-submission of the report will delay expense reimbursement, and make the PI ineligible for any future travel grants or seed funding.
